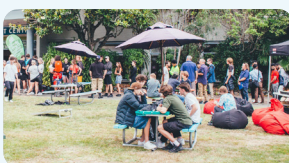

Explore the internal and external leadership challenges of conducting business with sustainability and the diversity of peoples' values in mind.

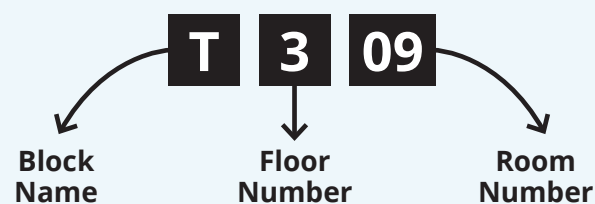
